Course The course will be a given list of buoys (from the [CCRC list](#)) to be rounded in any direction and in any order, except that Sparkes must be the fourth buoy to be rounded. One of these buoys will be the 'Joker' and will have to be rounded twice, once before rounding Sparkes and again after rounding Sparkes. This 'Joker' buoy will be announced on the day by the RO
