

These Race Instructions to be read in conjunction with CCRC Sailing Instructions 2020

Saturday 12 th September	Bramidge Trophy race PRO tba	CCRC v CYC
Sunday 13 th September	Bart's Bash race PRO tba Donations to the Andrew Simpson Foundation	all welcome

For the Bramidge trophy all boats – both CCRC and CYC will be rated on the NHC base number.
CYC ratings maybe adjusted

For Bart's Bash all visitors will be rated on NHC base number.

CCRC results for both events - Alpha fleet handicaps will be on VPRS rating
Beta fleet will be on own NHC number

Crew numbers to comply with the national social distancing guidelines

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Start time	1100hrs All fleets to start together with a rolling start – PRO (tba) will be the rolling start boat
Course	To be announced on the day by the PRO Listen on Channel (M)37 Course to be announced at 20mins and repeated at 10mins before the warning signal For Bart's Bash, subject to weather conditions, it is intended to use the laid bay marks just once for the start and again for the finish, ie long legs using the navigation marks only
Start Line	from - CHI, HARD or SPARKES to be selected on the day. It is the skipper's responsibility to allow sufficient time to locate the start mark and the start boat.
Finish Line	Will be announced with the course. Take your own finish time and text this to the results officer Guy McBride 07765 897002 [m], no later than 1hr after the race finish.
Time Limit	3 hours for first boat
