

These Race Instructions to be read in conjunction with CCRC Sailing Instructions 2020

Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> September

Passage to Cowes – **organised by Channel SC**  
Wooden Spoon Trophy race CCRC v CSC

Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> September

Passage return from Cowes  
PRO / RO tba

For the Wooden Spoon trophy all boats – both CCRC and CSC will be rated on the NHC base number.

CCRC results for both events - Alpha fleet handicaps will be on VPRS rating  
Beta fleet will be on own NHC number

Crew numbers to comply with the national social distancing guidelines

**Saturday** Start time **1230hrs from Gleeds** ,

**Course** will be announced on **VHF 72** (call sign JR) at 1130hrs and 1200hrs,  
time limit will be 3hrs

**Gate start** Papillon – Beneteau First 31.7 –  
gate boat and will sail a course at right angles to course of first mark

Finish times text to 07788 425945 with details boat in front and boat behind asap after finishing

**Sunday** Start Time 1000hrs from – Team O - this to be confirmed on the day.

All fleets to start together with a rolling start – PRO (tba) will be the rolling start boat

It is the skipper's responsibility to allow sufficient time to locate the start mark and the start boat.

**Course** To be **announced** on the day **by** the **PRO** Listen on Channel (M)37  
Course to be announced at 20mins and repeated at 10mins before the warning signal

**Finish Line** Will be announced with the course.

**Take your own finish time** and **text this to** the results officer Guy McBride **07765 897002** [m],  
**no later than 1hr after the race finish.**

**Time Limit** Sunday 4 hours for first boat

Sun 20<sup>th</sup> Sept HW 1415 ht 5.1 LW 1939

**Social** Due to government restrictions supper is own arrangement ie eat onboard, organise own fish & chips, pub etc

**Berthing** berth at Shepards Marina is pre booked for the following boats –  
Arcadia, Slipstream, Calypso, Markova, Celebration, Intrepid, Justify, Gypsy Girl,  
Encounter, Chimera, Rockhopper, Tucana

- 1 Any VHF communication by or with the RO shall be on Channel M (37)
- 2 The RO will not respond to calls from 5mins before the warning signal until after the final starting signal of the sequence.

### COVID-19

By taking part in this race, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that they are responsible for complying with any regulations and official guidance, including that issued by the RYA, in respect of COVID-19 as shall be in effect at the time.

There shall be no award ceremony following the racing or organised event supper in order to comply with the COVID19 regulations and restrictions.

Please do not arrange to meet in groups larger than 6 people and ensure that you partake in regular hand washing and sanitising.

Do not attend the event if you or anyone in your household is feeling unwell or should be quarantining.

We are strongly encouraging all boats to reduce their crew numbers to the minimum required for safety. Owing to this, it may mean that some boats are unable to fly spinnakers. To account for this, we are offering handicap reductions of 1% (rounded up) if you inform the race officer via email that you will not be using a spinnaker **before Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> September at 5pm** ([psimondavey@hotmail.com](mailto:psimondavey@hotmail.com)). You cannot decide this on the day of the race.

### The Race

Tidal Info	19/09/20: High Water Portsmouth:1330; Height: 5.0m
Start time	1230hrs
Start Line	The start will be by gate start - Papillon, a Beneteau First 31.7, will lay a line at right angles to the course to the first mark (Expected to be Gleeds).
Start sequence	The race will be started using the "5-4-1-go" sequence of RRS 26, with the warning signal 5 minutes before the starting signal. Using VHF Channel 72, call sign JR
Course	To be announced on the day on Channel 72 at 1130hrs and 1200hrs. In addition to this, we will aim to send the course to the 'CSC vs CCRC trophy' whats app group that you have been sent an invite to.
Finish	Mid Solent
Time Limit	3 hours after the first boat finishes

*Please take your own finish time and, if possible, make a note of the names/sail numbers of the boats ahead and astern. Please text this information to Simon Davey on 07788 425945 no later than 1hr after the race finish. As Simon will be returning back to his berth following the race, it is unlikely that he will be able to send out the results until Sunday morning.*
