Tack and Race Bay Series***revised instructions***

Saturday 27th June **Postponed to 4th July**

Saturday 4 th July	<i>Saturday series race 1</i>	start 1100	PRO	Mikado
Saturday 11 th July	<i>Saturday series race 2</i>	start 1200	PRO	Intrepid
Saturday 25 th July	<i>Saturday series race 3</i>	start 1200	PRO	Exeat

Sunday 28th June **Postponed to 5th July**

Sunday 5 th July	<i>Sunday series race 1</i>	start 1200	PRO	Rockhopper
Sunday 12 th July	<i>Sunday series race 2</i>	start 1200	PRO	Markova
Sunday 26 th July	<i>Sunday series race 3</i>	start 1200	PRO	The Harribelle

Both fleets to start together with a rolling start – PRO will be the rolling start boat

All boats to sail white sails only ie no downwind sails to be used

Crew numbers to comply with the national social distancing guidelines

Alpha fleet handicaps will be on VPRS non spinnaker rating

Beta fleet will be on NHC base number

If all 3 races are sailed in each of the series the best 2 results will count, but if 2 or less races are sailed all will count

Course To be **announced** on the day **by** the **PRO** Listen on Channel (M)37
Course to be announced at 20mins and repeated at 10mins before the warning signal

Start Line from - CHI, HARD or SPARKES to be selected on the day.

It is the skippers responsibility to allow sufficient time to locate the start mark and the start boat

Finish Line Will be announced with the course

Take your own finish time and text this to the results officer Guy McBride **07765 897002** [m],
no later than 1hr after the race finish.
