Course to be announced at 20mins and repeated at 10mins before the warning signal

Start Line Saturday - CHI, WE, SPARKES, HARD or RIZZI to be selected on the day.
Sunday – FUMESY, WILLIAM, ROYAL SOUTHERN to be selected on the day

It is the skippers responsibility to allow sufficient time to locate the start and rolling start boat.
Location of the start may announced by the PRO 1hr prior to the start time
