Location of the start may be announced by the PRO 1hr prior to the start time

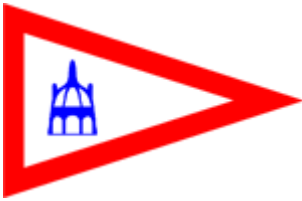
Finish Line Will be announced with the course

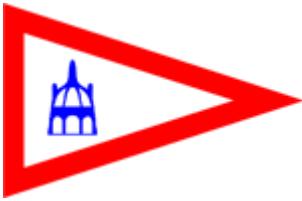
