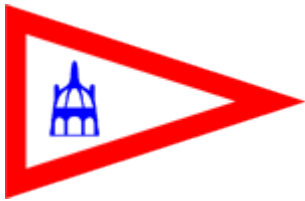

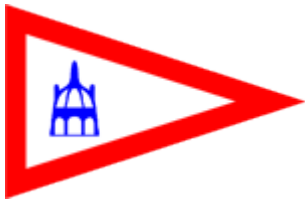

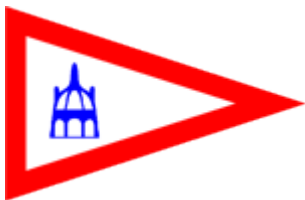

Earlier availability and berthing plan will be announced on WhatsApp. Bosun Call sign VHF Channel 77 call sign "Sea Echo".

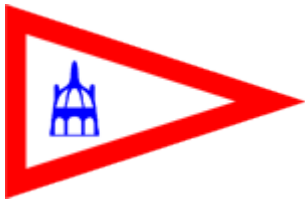
