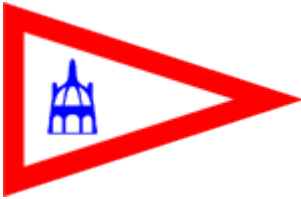

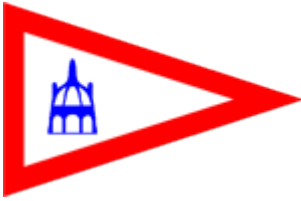

**Berthing** Arrangements have been made for CCRC boats to berth Saturday evening at Southsea Premier Marina in Langston Harbour.. CCRC has currently reserved 6 berths. Initial boat reservations are to be made on CCRC web site by Monday 13<sup>th</sup> July 2026. These will be sent to Southsea for payment on arrival.

Please note there is an automatic cill at the marina which closes entry to the marina approximately at 18.46 on Saturday see tide details below. After this time there is the Eastney waiting pontoon dredged to a minimum 2m low water springs. See Tide Tables for Southsea below for exit on Sunday at 13.25.

Please note the channel to the marina is only dredged to 0.5m LAT and it is advised to keep closer to red channel markers.

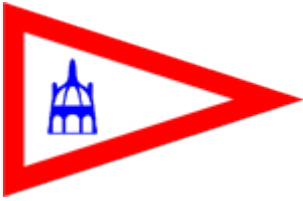
