1. Minutes of the Previous Meeting. The Minutes of the meeting held on 2nd September, 1980, were taken as read. There were no matters arising.

2. Racing Format for 1981. It was confirmed that there would be no changes in the racing format for 1981. Assistant Sailing Secretaries were asked to arrange special courses for passage races where possible in order to give Alpha boats a longer race than Beta. In addition, it was agreed that A.S.S.'s should not send out race instructions without discussing the notes on social activities with either Pam Kemp or the Hon. Secretary.

3. Beta Handicaps. It was agreed that the handicaps applying at the end of last season would be the basis for the start of the new season. The handicapper would err on the generous side when awarding handicaps to new boats. Reviews would be carried out, if possible, at each change of A.S.S.

4. Arrangements with H.I.S.C. Hugh Caldwell agreed to discuss arrangements with H.I.S.C. for payment by H.I.S.C. Boats. The basis of the arrangements to be no less favourable to C.C.R.C. than as agreed by the General Committee on the 22nd January, 1981 (Minute 10).

5. Safety Regulations. The Hon. Sailing Secretary would arrange for C.C.R.C. minimum safety regulations to be circulated to all members.

6. Letter to Owners. The draft circulated by the Hon. Sailing Secretary was agreed subject to certain minor modifications. P. Chivers kindly agreed to arrange for copying to be carried out and the Hon. Sailing Secretary would arrange for circulation.
