- 1. Apology for absence had been received from Hugh Caldwell
- 2. <u>Minutes of the Previous Meeting</u>: the Minutes of the meeting held on 19th March, 1981, had been circulated and were taken as read. There were no matters arising.
- 3. Programme for 1982. The Hon. Sailing Secretary presented a draft programme for discussion. It was agreed that as a new Sailing Secretary would be taking over, who had yet to be appointed, discussion should concentrate on general principles and that a further meeting would be held before the A.G.M. to discuss detail. The following general points were agreed:
 - a) The balance of the 1981 programme as between passage races and Hayling Bay races was about right.
 - b) There should continue to be two cross-channel races. The possibility of going to Le Havre instead of Ouistreham on May 29 would be examined. It was imperative to have formal alternative race instructions should that cross-channel event have to be cancelled.
 - c) The A.G.M. would be asked for their reaction to a cruise in company to the West Country rather than Brittany to follow the Cherbourg race on 17 July.
 - d) Race to Brighton over August Bank Holiday.
 - e) It was thought that the concept of a jig-saw race was too complicated and that Bembridge would therefore not be included in the programme.
 - f) Include a pursuit race.
 - g) Try to rearrange the Itchenor Casket for either 11 or 25 September.
 - h) N.A.B. Cups to be included in C.C.R.C. programme.
 - i) Try to arrange a weekend with Sonatas as requested but priority to be given to joint race with C.Y.C.
 - j) Encourage Trapper 300's to join C.C.R.C. for a passage race.
- 4. NextMeeting: this was arranged for 28 October, 1981, at the offices of Messrs. Pember & Boyle at 6.0~p.m.
- 5. There being no other business, the Meeting closed at 8.10 p.m.
