Treasurer's Report for CCRC Committee Meeting on Saturday 11th January 2020

Bank Balance is currently a total of £6,951.39 (£4,401.93 in current a/c, £2,549.46 in 2nd account) (as at 7th January 2020).

Subscription payments so far this year (since 1st October 2019) have been made to Chichester Harbour Federation (£55), RYA (£155), Solent Protection (£25) and Solent Cruising Racing Association (£100).

The deposit of £120 has now been received back from Lymington Yacht Haven and the duplicated payment of £80 to Solent Cruising & SCRA has also been received (both shown in last year's accounts as pending receipt). (Note: Future payments to Solent Cruising & SCRA will be made by SO)

Deposit of £100 has been paid to Lymington Yacht Haven for Dan Bran pontoon for 6th June 2020 passage race.

Expenditure for various engraving, replacement parts for trophies and glasses for annual prize giving / dinner dance in November 2019 totalled £940.00.

A payment of £80 was made to Inspired Media for advertising in the Solent Handbook and Directory in December.

As at 7th January memberships have been received in the sum of £480 (24 members) and boat registrations in the sum of £450 (9 boats), making a total received to date of £930 (of which £90 is currently held in the 'new' paypal account which was set up by Bob Garrett).
